## Rules

- You, the student, will be expected to enter the classroom on time in an orderly manner. After three (3) unexcused lates the student will be assigned an after school detention.
- Hoodies, jackets and any other outerwear must be placed in locker before entering homeroom. Further, if you, the student, does not have enough time to place hoodies, jackets or other outerwear in your locker it must be off before entering the classroom.
- Book bags should be placed under your desk and out of the aisle.
- Students will remain seated until the bell rings. Please remember that the teacher dismisses the class, not the bell.
- There will be NO food, gum or drinks in the classroom. Bottled water is the ONLY exception to this rule.
- Cursing and foul language will not be tolerated.

• This is an English speaking school and classroom—any other language other than English will not be tolerated.

- Be polite. Manners are a must! This includes raising hand to be acknowledged.
- Do not speak while I am speaking, Mrs. [REDACTED] is speaking, or while another student is speaking. It is terribly rude.
- You must leave the classroom in the same working order as you found it.
- Defacing, vandalism or destruction of furniture or equipment will result in appropriate consequences.
